It was completed by 1968 and is located at Niger state. 2. Jebba hydro power station reservoir Jebba power station is hydro-electric powered.

Who manages power plants in Niger?

These plants are managed by generation companies (GenCos), independent power providers, and Niger Delta Holding Company. The primary independent power plants before the power sector reforms are Shell-owned Afam VI (642MW), Agip-built Okpai plant (480 MW), and AES (270 MW).

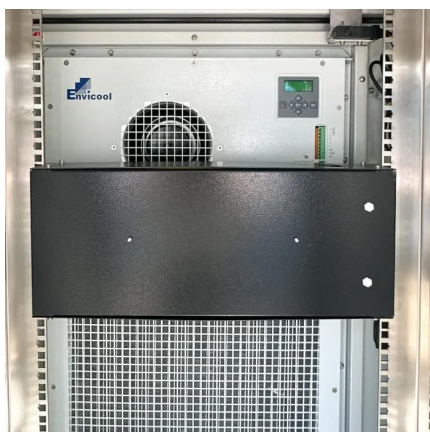
